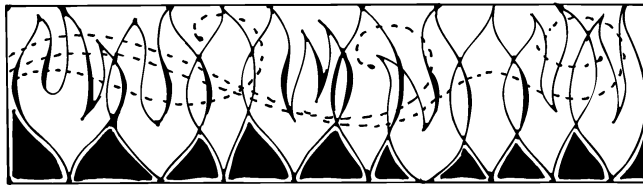


## **SUMMER OFFERINGS**
