Our May outreach project is breakfast cereal for Miriam's House, a transitional housing facility for homeless women and children. Please place cereal in the outreach basket in the narthex.

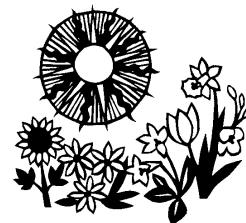

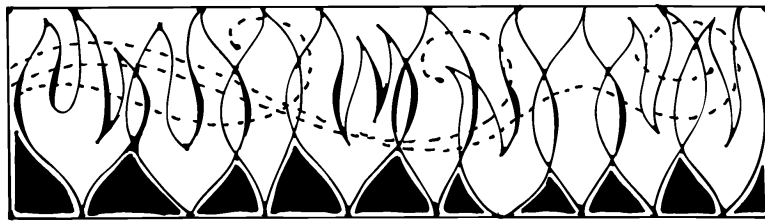
Join us for a time of spiritual nourishment as we gather for quiet reflection, prayer, the Word, and the Meal.
