

CONFIRMATION MINISTRY

Grades Six through Eight

Confirmation classes are held for those in sixth, seventh, and eighth grades. In the course of the three-year catechetical program, the youth study the Bible and its interpretation, Lutheran Church history, Luther's Small Catechism (Ten Commandments, The Apostles' Creed, Lord's Prayer, Holy Baptism, and Holy Communion), worship, liturgy, hymnody, discipleship, and the church year. Eighth graders participate in a comprehensive examination at the conclusion of the program as they prepare for the Rite of Confirmation.

Confirmation classes will be held from 5:45 - 7:00 p.m. on the following Sundays:

In addition, there are homework and Sunday morning worship assignments, independent learning activities, serving as an acolyte, and service project requirements.
